In the early days of AA, we had the Alcoholic Foundation rather than the General Service Board. The Foundation handled the money matters while Bill handled the rest of the world services. Eventually the Foundation took on more and more responsibility as the fellowship grew, including the 2 corporations of AAWS and the Grapevine as well as all the legal affairs. Bill and Dr. Bob served as the link between the Trustees and the groups. Realizing a more permanent link was needed, the Conference was created to replace Bill and Dr Bob.
